Tournament Rules

1. Entry Fee - \$75 per Angler
2. Captains Meeting: Friday, May 25, 2018, at Farm Bureau Pavilion. Registration is from 5:30-6:30 PM with the Captain's Meeting starting at 6:30 PM. Dinner will be provided. The address is 7289 Palmer Blvd, Sarasota, FL 34240.
3. Maximum of 4 anglers per boat, Boats checked/released from Ken Thompson Boat ramp Saturday, am.
4. Fishing Hours: Safe Daylight - 3:00 PM
5. Boats must check in at weigh-in tent, at Ken Thompson Park, before 3:00 PM. Late arrivals will be disqualified from the tournament.
6. All fish must be caught by hook, line, rod and reel and only by members of your fishing team.
7. No wading.
8. All team members must obey all State of Florida fishing and boating regulations, including size and bag limits.
9. All teams must maintain a distance of 50 yards from the other boats in the tournament.
10. Total number of spots on a Redfish, within the legal slot of 18"-27", with a tail pinch and released swim away under its own power.
11. In the event of a tie, the first team/boat to check in will be the winning team/boat.
12. The Redfish with the most spots wins.
13. All Redfish must be brought to the scales alive.
14. All proceeds from the event go to benefit Gator Wilderness Camp School. All team members must obey all State of Florida fishing and boating regulations, including size and bag limit
